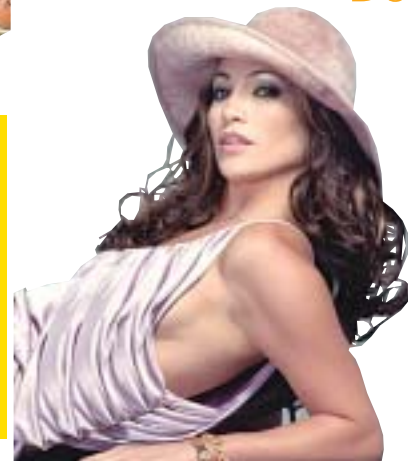

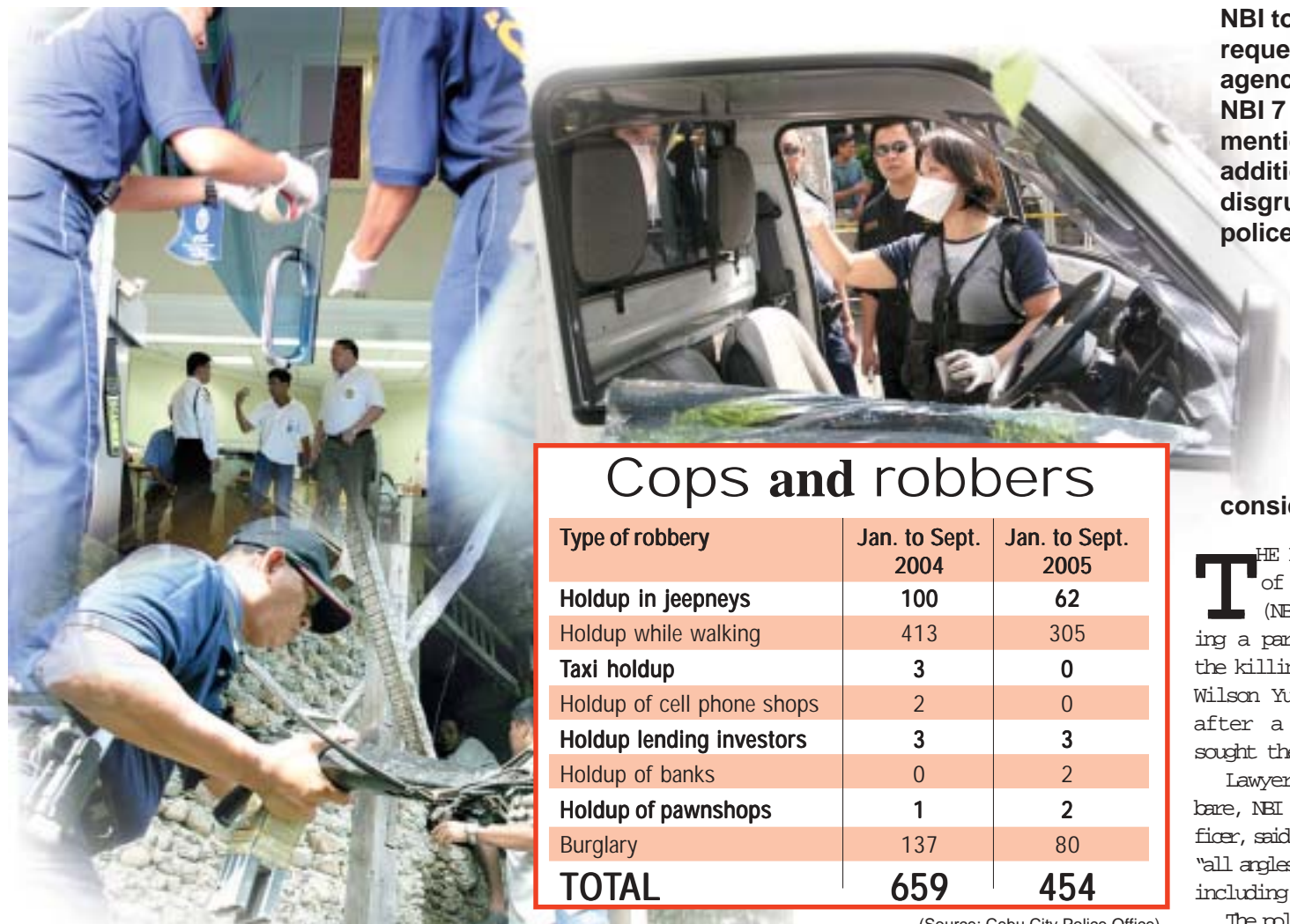

NBI to make parallel investigation, following request of the family of Wilson Yu for agency to help

NBI 7 executive officer Ernesto Macabare mentions gambling as one theory, in addition to business rivalry and revenge of disgruntled employees earlier cited by police

Investigators have no leads yet but consider at least two witnesses

**T**HE National Bureau of Investigation (NBI) 7 is launching a parallel probe into the killing of businessman Wilson Yu last Thursday, after a family member sought the bureau's help. Lawyer Ernesto Macabare, NBI 7's executive officer, said they will look into "all angles" of the shooting, including gambling.

The police is also checking whether the ambush of the businessman in Barangay Cabancalan, Mandaue City had something to do with a business rivalry or revenge by

disgruntled workers.

The Mandaue City Government and the Mandaue Chamber of Commerce and Industry (MCCI) are offering a total of P100,000 for the suspects' capture, dead or alive.

MCCI president Eric Mendoza said the group is willing to help solve the crime, even if the 45-year-old Yu was not a member.

Yu owned WAM Manufacturing and Development Inc., a surplus shop and franchises of fastfood chains Jollibee and Chowking.

## Petty thefts down but...

MORE robberies happened in Cebu City from January to September last year than during the same period this year. The same trend was noted in snatching incidents.

The Cebu City Police Office (CCPO) recorded

... no stop to robberies Vigilante killings scare only small-time offenders?

659 robberies for the first nine months of last year and 454 this year.

The report categorized the robberies into eight

types: holdup in public jeepney, holdup while walking, taxi holdup, holdups in cell phone shops, lending investors, banks

and pawnshops, and burglaries.

Most robbery victims were pedestrians.

Police records show that 413 street holdups were carried out last year and 305 such crimes this year.
